Code of Conduct for Spectators:

- Respect for the game, children and coaches by refraining from using obscene language or gestures and aggressive behavior
 - The site supervisor will ask you to remove yourself from the premises if this is an issue. Failure to leave will result in the police being called.
- Respect for officials, coaches, other players and fans
 - Approaching an official with negative comments is prohibited
 - Be supportive of the coaches – do not coach from the sideline
 - Remember that the athletes are children – treat them the way you would like to have your own child treated
- Respect for schools, gyms, and fields
 - For the safety of your young children, please supervise them at all times
- Provide or arrange for transportation to all practices, games and tournaments
- Demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, represent OLP positively
 - Provide a positive experience for the athlete
- Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and smokeless tobacco are prohibited at OLP MCYO League Events
- All practices are CLOSED. This means that all parents are asked to stay out of the gym until the end of practice. You may watch from the window in the doors if you like or ask the coach if you can sit on the bleachers. If you need to speak to the coaches, please do so before or after practice.
- Supporting OLP Athletics is a requirement of having your child participate in sports. Please extend your support by volunteering for adult supervision of concessions and any other event that needs volunteers (i.e. tournaments)
